Ranch Boarding Rules

All boarders and riding visitors must sign, understand and agree to the terms listed in the "Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement".

Stable is open from 6:00 am to 9:00 pm.

Please schedule private training lessons in the arena with management.

No horses may be left unsupervised in the arena or round pens.

Absolutely NO SMOKING except in designated areas.

Dogs are not allowed on the property.

Children under 13 must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Horse owners (or lessors) are responsible for repairs of untoward damage caused by their horses or vehicles.

30 days notice must be given by boarder or management for termination of boarding agreements except for immediate termination in the case of non-payment, animal endangerment or animal abuse.

Illegal or cruel behavior toward animals or others will not be tolerated.

Individual Item Charges

Medication: Administration of veterinary approved medications, prescribed medicines and supplements, including pain medication, antibiotics and injections, does not include medication costs: \$3 (included in Therapeutic Boarding)

Worming: Worming of horses on designated schedule or as needed with herbal worming program, includes cost of herbs and administration: \$40 Follow up fecal exams available at cost.

Nutritional and Wellness Consultation: BioEnergy Analysis exam using applied kinesiology and kinetic structure evaluation: \$35

Horse Transport: Transport of horses to/from Grand Adventures Ranch to veterinary hospital or other locations: \$60 per hour plus 25¢ per mile

Hand Walking: Hand walking of horses for 20 minutes: \$5

Turnout: Additional paddock, arena or pasture turnout: \$3

Hot Walking: Motorized hot walker use is free to all boarders.

Round Pen Workout: ½ hour round pen exercise session: \$15

Grand Grooming Package: Brushing & Bathing with chemical-free Dynamite® shampoo and conditioner, hoof conditioning treatment: \$20

Late Charges: Charge for payments not received by 7th of each month: \$25
